



## SCHOOLS ARTS FESTIVAL 2024

As part of Artscape's ongoing vision to develop a love for the performing arts, and contributing to practical nation building, we invite schools to this wonderful opportunity for learners. In August, yearly, approximately 14 schools share the same stage each evening, contributing to an exciting and diverse theatre experience, from classical choirs to contemporary dance. The festival culminates in a glittering Gala performance by selected schools, attended by various dignitaries and showcases the talent which exists in our schools. A panel of adjudicators select on merit, 18 Schools that perform at the Gala Event.

### Criteria:

- This festival is open to both Primary and High Schools.
- Dance, Poetry, Music (instrumental and/or vocal performances), Choral items **ONLY**.  
*Drama pieces we will not be accepted*
- Schools may enter more than one item for consideration;

### Closing date for entry forms will be on Monday 3 June 2024.

Schools will be informed of their performance date by Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> June 2024.

### School's Arts Festival Dates

The festival at Artscape Theatre will run from 19<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> August 2024.

The 18 schools that are selected by the panel will represent their school at the Gala Event held on the 29<sup>th</sup> August 2024.

## INFORMATION FOR PARTSIPANTS SCHOOLS ARTS FESTIVAL, AUGUST 2024

1. Each performance piece **MUST** be between 5 and 8 minutes. Non adherence will result in disqualification.
2. **Schools will be informed of their performance date by Tuesday 11th June 2024.**
3. There will be a technical rehearsal on the day of the performance on stage in the afternoon. All schools to be present by 13h00.
4. Educators are responsible for supervising the learners while they are on Artscape premises. Holding rooms will be provided. Please ensure that each learner has a packed lunch.
5. Musical Groups (bands) have to bring their own instruments including keyboards and music stands. Artscape will provide a baby grand piano, a drum kit, guitar amp, bass amp and 6 hand held microphones.
6. Dance groups need to supply quality recordings of their selected music on a USB FLASH DRIVE in MP3 or WAV format. All music must be clearly marked. These devices should be collected on the day of the performance. Music which is not in this format cannot be played.
7. Artscape provides basic lighting and the technical team. Please refrain from extravagant lighting set-up as we are sharing the theatre with another production.
8. Artscape will contact your school to confirm the details of your performance. Please have your technical requirements ready.
9. Please ensure that you have your information ready about your school and performance piece.
10. Should the entry be a community group, the schools represented within the group must be documented as well as the contact number of each school.
11. This event is for scholars only, from Grade 1 to 12.
12. Please note, this festival is for Dance, Poetry, Music (instrumental and/or vocal performances), Choral performances **ONLY**. We will not accept any Drama pieces.
