

WCED POST LEVEL 1 ITINERANT MUSIC TEACHING POST

The Hugo Lambrechts Music Centre, a Western Cape Education Department (WCED) institution, is establishing a satellite campus in the Overberg District. Based in Bredasdorp, the campus will provide Practical, Music Theory, and FET Subject Music tuition to learners in Bredasdorp, Napier, Elim, Arniston (Waenhuiskrans) and Struisbaai. The initial focus will be on piano, recorder and Music Theory tuition, with other orchestral instruments to follow.

A new WCED itinerant music teaching post has been created, linked to the Hugo Lambrechts Music Centre, and based in Bredasdorp. Being the pioneer in a new post at the new satellite campus, the educator must be able to work independently and travel to the Overberg partnership schools daily, as well as to the Music Centre in Parow from time-to-time.

Potential candidates are hereby invited to apply for this post via the WCED E-Recruitment portal (https://e-recruitment.westerncape.gov.za/).

Working hours: Monday to Friday 11:00 - 18:00, with flexitime as needed to accommodate itinerant teaching, meetings, rehearsals, and concerts after hours.

Core duties:

- 1. Teaching piano/recorder at partnership schools in the Overberg District as part of the WCED itinerant teaching programme. Tuition must include technique, repertoire, musical development, performance practice and aural awareness.
- 2. Teaching Music Theory and FET Subject Music (CAPS Curriculum) at partnership schools in the Overberg District as part of the WCED itinerant teaching programme.
- 3. Preparing learners for all internal concerts and assessments, as well as external examinations, subject examinations, eisteddfodau, and concerts.
- 4. Maintaining clear and detailed learner records pertaining to term planning, weekly lessons, rehearsals, assessments, and communication with learners, parents, and staff at participating partnership schools.
- 5. Conducting assessments at internal Music Centre and Subject Examinations as determined by the Music Centre principal.
- 6. Coaching and conducting ensembles.
- 7. Executing administrative duties as stipulated in the generic WCED Job Description for Educators.

Requirements:

- A recognized 3-year tertiary music qualification which includes piano/recorder teaching methodology.
- Proof of SACE registration / application for registration.
- Fluency in English and Afrikaans.

Recommendations:

- A 4-year music qualification or higher
- Experience of and ability to teacher other instruments such as guitar/flute/ clarinet/ violin/trumpet.
